YEAR 2023 IN REVIEW

We the staff of The Bojang Foundation would like to thank you on behalf of all the
Orphans and neglected children in The Gambia, Cameroon & Guinea Bissau. Thank you
very much for all your needed support and help. May Allah continue to accept and
fully reward your efforts in this life & the hereafter Insha'Allah.

Year 2023 was another very interesting and busy year Masha'Allah. It was almost as busy as it was when we were dealing with COVID-19 in 2020. It maybe the busiest year since the foundation was founded back in 2009, Alhamdulillah rabil A'lamin.

1- In Cameroon Refugee Camps: With the help of Allah (SWT), we were able to start and complete the construction of seven major Projects, Alhamdulillah Rabil A'lamin. A new Qur'anic school was built from the ground up, alongside the renovation of an old Islamic school. We were also able to build 3 new masjids in 3 different refugee settlements and, also dug up 3 borehole wells to provide clean water.

YEAR 2023 IN REVIEW (con)

- <u>2- In the Gambia</u>: we Dug about 5 local Wells, 4 Electric/Solar Boreholes, alongside the installation of roofs on 6 unfinished homes just in time for the rainy season. We were also able to purchase a 30x30 empty land to move a nearby Qura'nic school with about 100 kids, because of an eviction due to the landlord needing her property back.
- 3- In Guinea Bissau, a Muslim minority country:, We Built a brand new Islamic/Qura'nic school from the ground up, outside the Bafata region. Which happens to be the only Islamic school within the whole region.
- All these outlined projects are for Construction projects only, the rest of the other foundation projects is not included in this report. Such as paying hospital and medical bills for those who can't afford it, paying monthly rent & providing food to many widows and the orphans living under their care, Paying high school & collage tuition fees for many Orphans and very poor students since the beginning of the foundation. We also slaughter at least 50 cows or more each year which include: 2 cows or more every month in both The Gambia and Cameroon to provide food for the orphans and the poor children, 26 cows every Ramadan for the daily iftar in the refugee settlements and for the orphans in the Quranic schools. We also purchased 6 handicap bicycles to help the handicap refugee kids to move around, a big motorcycle with a trailer for Janaza services. None of which would be possible without your help.

2024 UP COMING PROJECTS IN CAMEROON "PROJECT NUMBER ONE"

BUILDING A 4 BEDROOM, 1 LIVING ROOM + 2 BATHROOM HOUSE FOR QURA'NIC TEACHER

Sheikh Mohammed Baguirou a refugee living in one of the United Nations refugee settlement camps in Lolo, Cameroon. He started teaching the Holy Qur'an and general Islamic education to refugee kids in the camp 10 years ago with no salary or financial funding from any one at all. His case was brought our attention last year 2022 through our representative in Cameroon, Imam Maloum Dijido.

Sheikh Mohammed is an old, weak and very poor man due the lack of financial assistance for him and his Qura'nic school. He is unable to take care of himself let alone his family financially. The foundation did its best to support him, his family and his Qura'nic school since his situation came to our attention.

Right before the end of last year's rainy season, part of his mud house started falling down due to a serious leakage on the roof. Due to the foundation dealing with so many different projects, we were unable to help his unfortunate situation and decided to push his case to 2024 Insha'Allah.

The total cost to build 4 bedroom, 1 Living room & 2-bathroom brick house for this very poor Quranic teacher is

PROJECT NUMBER TWO

BUILDING A 4 BEDROOM, 1 LIVING ROOM, 2 BATHROOM NEW HOUSE FOR 4 HANDICAPED ORPHANS IN ONE OF THE UN REFUGEE SETTLMENT CAMPS IN LOLO, CAMEROON

The total cost to build a 4 bedroom, 1 living room and 2 bathrooms brick house for these 4 very poor Handicap Orphans is almost the same as the previous project



PROJECT NUMBER THREE 3

FINISHING THE BUILDING OF MASJID UM MUSA FROM GROUND UP

This Masjid was one of the last two Masjids we were building for newly arriving refugees in two settlements in Bartour, Cameroon, last year. Due to a lack of enough funding, we were unable to complete this project. Therefore, we decided to push it to 2024, Insha'Allah.

The cost to completely rap up this project is = 4 steel doors + 4 steel widows = 2,700 Dollars. Masjid Carpet = 2,800 Dollar

Total Amount Needed = 2700 + 2800 = &3,500 Dollars







PROJECT NUMBER FOUR 4

FINISHING UP TWO ADDITIONAL VERY NEEDED SMALL PROJECTS NEAR IAR MASJID IN CAMEROON

Right before the end of the construction of the 2nd Masjid built by IAR in the refugee camps in Cameroon' some of the community members of the Masjid brought to our attention the importance of adding a bathrooms & a Janaza service room because there was none around the area at all. With the help of Allah, we started both projects, But due to lack of funds we decided to postpone to 2024 Insha'Allah.

The Total amount needed to wrap up these two small projects is:

2 steel doors and 2 windows for the bathroom + 1 steel door and 1 window for the Janaza room + 20 bags of Cement

TOTAL = \$5,500 Dollars
